For this design you will be making three strands of beads using simple wire loops. Please adjust the length to suit your needs. It may be helpful for you to make the strands and then put together one side of the necklace with the strand reducer then adjusting as needed before finishing the design by adding or subtracting beads.

- 1. Take one eye pin. String on one 10mm bead. Make a simple wire loop. Set aside. Repeat 30 times.
- 2. Then open and close the simple wire loops, same as you would a jump ring to attach them together to make a chain. Set the chain aside.
- 3. Repeat the above two steps to make a chain 41 beads in length of the 8mm beads, and 55 beads in length of the 6mm beads.
