A simple strand of tigers eye gemstones is embellished with glimmering hexagon spacers of gold for added sophistication.

### What You'll Need

Tiger Tigers Eye Gem Round 6mm Beads/15.5 (Brown & Gold)

[XTL-3000] Bead Stopper- Stop Beads Sliding Off Stringing Material



## Instructions

This design measures approximately 18 inches. To modify the length, simply adjust the number of beads strung.

1. Cut off 24 inches of beading wire. Place a bead stopper about two inches from one end.
2. String the beads in the following order: 24 gemstones, 15 metal beads, 7 gemstones, 15 metal beads, 7 gemstones, 15 metal beads and 24 gemstones.
