To create the triangle, follow this pattern: weave four rows of $11 / 0$ magental lined crystal
AB Miyki Delicas, four rows of 1110 silver Iined mauve Miyki Delicas, four rows of $11 /$

. Using your flush cutters, cut a two foot long piece of beading wire. Secure one end with a
Onto the wire, thread the following:
a siver lined maune crystiyki AB Melica, alight cranbery lined topaz Iuster Miyuki
and a dyed opaque cranberry Miyuki Delica
This beading pattern will be henceforth referrred to as "A .
Now thread:
oa 4 mm dark red coral Swarovski crystal bicone or "B"

- A 4 mm Light Siam AB Swarovski rrystal bicone


a 4 mm amethyst Swarovski crystal bicone
$\therefore$ A
Repeat this stringing sequence two more times, for a total of three.

5. Thread your wire through the central four beads on a flat side of your triangle foca
6. Move the pendant to the center of your wire
7. Thread the other half of your necklace as a mirror image of the first.
8. At the end of your strand, thread a crimp bead, but do not crimp it yet. Thread your wire through the loop on one half of your class, back through the crimp bead and several
consecutively strung beads, pull your wire relatively snug (leave some wiggle room for consecutively strung beads, pull your
