## Instructions

This necklaces measures 16 " long. To make your necklace longer or shorter, simply adjust the length of faux leather.

1. Begin by cutting two 11 " lengths of brown faux leather cord with your flush cutters. Set aside.
2. Next, cut three lengths of wire: 14 ", 15 " and 17 ". (I have already included 3 " of beading wire on each side of your lengths of wire to allow for crimping.)
3. Take one length of faux leather, and onto both ends, attach a gold plated ribbon pinch crimp ends using your chain nose pliers. You can see a video on how to do this here.
4. Open a gold plated 5 mm jump ring (using your chain nose pliers) and slide it onto one of the ribbon crimp ends on one end of one length of faux leather. Before closing, slide on the loop from one half of your gold plated metallic clasp and close. Close the jump ring.
5. Open a 8 mm gold plated jump ring with your chain nose pliers and slide it onto the loop on the ribbon crimp end on the other side of that faux leather cord length. Close the jump ring.
6. Take your 14" length of beading wire and string it through the jump ring. Also slide on a gold plated crimp tube. String your wire back through crimp tube (you want a short tail of about 3 inches of wire).
7. Pull snug so that you have a small loop.
8. Using your crimping pliers, crimp crimp the crimp tube. Do not trim off the short tail because you will be adding beads onto it for added security.
9. Onto this 14 " length of wire, string on: 20 gold seed beads, 1 cathedral bead, 1 gold seed bead, 1 cathedral bead, 1 seed bead, 1 cathedral bead, 1 seed bead, 1 TierraCast coil edge spacer bead, 1 turquoise rondelle bead, 1 spacer bead, 1 rondelle bead, 1 spacer bead, 1 rondelle bead, 1 spacer, 1 rondelle, spacer, rondelle, 1 spacer, 1 rondelle, 1 spacer, 1 gold seed bead, 1 cathedral bead, 1 gold seed bead, 1 cathedral bead, 1 seed bead, 1 cathedral bead, 1 seed bead, 1 cathedral bead and another 20 gold seed beads. Also add on 1 crimp tube. Attach your bead stopper and set down.
10. Open a gold plated 5 mm jump ring (using your chain nose pliers) and slide it onto a ribbon crimp end on the second length of faux leather. Before closing, slide on the loop from one half of your gold plated metallic clasp and close. Close the jump ring.
11. Take your wire length and string it through another 8 mm gold plated jump ring. Bring it back through the crimp tube, pull snug and crimp the crimp tube. Snip off any excess wire using your flush cutters.
12. Onto the ribbon crimp end on the other side of that same length of faux leather, open and attach another 5 mm jump ring and the second half of your metallic clasp and close.
13. Next, take your 15 " length of wire and repeat the previous crimping process. Add onto this wire one 1 crimp tube and 38 gold seed beads. Then add 1 coral bead, 1 gold bead, 1 turquoise bead, and 1 gold bead. Repeat this sequence 5 more times. Attach the end of the wire onto the jump ring in the same manner as before.
14. Attach your last length of 17 " wire like how you did before. Onto this length of wire add 1 crimp tube, 25 matubo beads, 1 hexagon rondelle, and 1 matubo bead, Repeat this sequence 8 more times, ending with a hexagon bead. Next, add 10 red Pastella beads, followed by 9 more sets of hexagon and matubo beads. Lastly, add on 25 more matubo beads and a crimp tube.
15. Slide the wire through the jump ring and finish off the same way as before. Your three lengths of beaded wire should be attached. See photo for comparison.
16. Close your magnetic clasp and you're done!
