This eye-catching necklace features an impressive scarab set upon a large turquoise jasper teardrop pendant. Aquamarine gemstone chips turquoise dyed jasper beads and siver-plated hexagon beads round out this lovely piece.

NOTE: The 6 mm round jasper beads originally in this project (and showing in the photograph) have been substituted with 6 mm bue
turcuoise beads. These new beads are a little lighter in color then the iasper will still compliment the scarab pendant nicely.

## Instructions

Begin this project by creating your pendant. Cut 12 inches of 24 gauge wire and thread it through the hole at the top of your turquoise teardrop pendant. Pull the wire through so that you have 8 inches on one side and 4 inches on the other. Create a
briolette wrap sing the longer end of the wire to wrap around the top of your teardrop pendant. Keep wrapping so that you cove brioette wrap using the longer end of the wire to wrap around the top of your teardrop pendant. Keep wrapping so
about $1 / 8$ inch of the teardrop peak. Finish off your wrapping. When you finish, you should have a loop at the top

Take a toothpick or small piece of wire and apply a generous amount of E6000 adhesive to the back side of your scarab. Try to ge the glue into the hollow interior space of the scarab and along the flat portions but not in the areas which can be seen from the ther side. Center your scarab onto of your teardrop pendant so that the head faces towards the loop you made in step 1 . Press
nto place. If any glue seeps out around the edges, take a clean toothpick or piece of wire and gently scrape it off. Set aside to dry for several hours before handling
Cut a 25 inch length of beading wire. Place a bead stopper on one end (leaving a 3 inch tail) and string the following
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- a turquoise dyed jasper round bead
- a turquoise dyed jasper round bea

3 aquamarine gemstone chips
and the pendant you made in
4. Start beading the second half your necklace making it a mirror image of the first, ending in a crimp bead
5. Now thread one end of your beading wire through the ring that comes with your $S$-hook. Thread the wire back through your crimp bead and a couple of the beads next to it. Pull snug and crimp the crimp bead. Cut off excess beading wire. Apply a crimp cover o 6. Remove the bead stopper at the other end and attach the S -hook the same way you attached the ring in the previous step.
7. Enjoy your lovely new necklace!
