Instructions

These instructions will make an 18 inch necklace. For a longer or shorter necklace, adjust the length of chain on both sides of the focal flag.

- 1. To begin, please watch our video on how to do square stitch bead weaving.
- 2. Cut a length of Fireline thread as long as you are comfortable working with and thread a size 12 beading needle. You will need to tie off and add new thread as you work. Attach a stopper bead on one end of your thread, leaving a 6 inch tail.
- 3. String your first row of 18 red Delica beads. You will be following the bead weaving pattern shown in the photo, beginning with the red stripe at the bottom and using square stitch to work your way upward. Your first 6 rows will be solid stripes before you get to the area with blue beads and white "stars." NOTE: You can choose your favorite shade of blue beads to use from the blue Delica mix!
- 4. When you've finished weaving the flag, tie off and weave in your thread tails.
- 5. Using flush cutters, cut a 3 inch piece of 22 gauge wire. Straighten the wire with nylon jaw pliers if necessary.
- 6. Grip one end of the wire in the tips of your round nose pliers and twist your wrist forward to create a loop.
- 7. Thread the straight part of the wire through the top row of beads in the flag, and slide the flag down to the loop you created in the previous step.
- 8. Grip the straight part of the wire about 1/4 inch from the end of the flag and twist your wrist forward to create another loop. Cut off the excess wire with flush cutters.
- 9. Cut two 8 inch lengths of matte gold chain.
- 10. Open one of the wire loops on one side of the flag the same way you would open a jump ring. Slide on the first link of one piece of chain. Close the loop.
- 11. Repeat step 10 with the second length of chain to create the other side of the necklace.
- 12. Open the loop of one spring ring clasp. Slide it onto the last link of chain on one side. Close the loop.
- 13. Open a jump ring. Slide it onto the last link of chain on the other side of the necklace. Close the jump ring.
- 14. Close the clasp, and enjoy your necklace!
