What You'll Need

Gun Metal Plated Corrugated Bead Caps - 3.5mm Diameter (100)

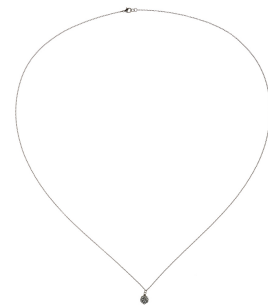

Instructions

1. This necklace is quite long, 36. If you want a shorter necklace, just cut your chain accordingly before you begin this project.
2. Place onto a head pin 1 bead cap facing upwards and 1 Beadelle pave crystal bead. After the bead, create a wrapped wire loop. NOTE: Make sure your wrapped wire loop is large enough to thread your chain through in the next step.

3. Thread one end of your chain through the wrapped wire loop you just made.
4. On one end of your chain, open and connect a 4mm jump ring. Before closing the jump ring, also link onto it a 6mm closed jump ring. Close the jump ring.
5. On the other side of the chain, open and connect another 4mm jump ring. Before closing this jump ring, also link onto it your lobster clasp. Close the jump ring.
6. All done!
