What You'll Need

Create Recklessly, Artist's Concrete for Mixed Media, 8 Ounce Jar

Instructions

Please note you will also need a disposable mixing cup, some way of measuring tablespoons and teaspoons, tap water, and something such as a popsicle stick to stir your concrete.

- 1. Please watch the video: How to Make Concrete Jewelry.
- 2. In the video you will learn how to mix your concrete and also how to make this pendant. Let cure before going onto the next step.
- 3. For the necklace, it is simply 3 feet of chain. Slide your pendant onto the chain. The chain links are all open, not soldered, meaning that you can use them just like jump rings. Open the end chain link and connect it to the chain link on the other end of your 3 feet of chain. Close the link back up.
- 4. All done, enjoy!
