

Rambling Rose Necklace

A curling vine of rosy coils form a pendant using 18 gauge craft wire. Contrasting 26 gauge hematite wire, 2mm oval cable chain, and Swarovski Crystal pearls add an antiqued touch.

What You'll Need

Wire Elements, Tarnish Resistant Rose Gold Wire, 18 Gauge 10 Yards (9.14 Meters)

Instructions

These instructions will make a 17 inch necklace. To adjust the size, modify the length of chain used on either side respectively.

1. To see how to create this design from start to finish, please watch the video: How to Make a Wire Wrapped Connector with Bail Making Pliers. First you will see how to form 18 gauge wire into the shape shown. Then you will see how to wire wrap Swarovski Crystal pearls onto the form using contrasting 26 gauge wire. You will also see how to attach a chain and clasp.
