Create a layered necklace look using round sequin connector chain, gemstone chain, and rolo chain. All three chains are connected at the back of the necklace using pretty strand reducers. The final touch is a little Om charm hanging from the longest necklace chain.

Bulk Chain, with 6mm Round Sequin Connector Links, Sold By The Foot, Gold Plated
