[XTL-0020] Baby Wubbers Quality Fine Chain Nose Jeweller's Pliers, [XTL-5600] Sharp Flush Cutter Pliers - For Cutting Beading Wire, 1 Piece, [XTL-5200] Standard Size Beading Crimping Pliers (For 2x2mm & 2x1mm Crimp Beads), [XTL-3000] Bead Stopper- Stop Beads Sliding Off Stringing Material

Instructions

This necklace measures 30 inches and can easily fit over the head.

1. Begin by watching the video: How to Finish Zola Elements Tassels for Jewelry. In the course of the video you will learn how to add a closed jump ring to your tassel and then secure it with a crimp bead and crimp bead cover. Follow the directions in the video to finish your tassel.

2. Next, cut 38 inches of beading wire and place a bead stopper on the end, 4 inches from the tail.

3. String on the following beads: 1 crimp bead, 25 round wood beads, 1 gemstone bead, 1 round wood bead, 1 pewter bead, 1 tapered oval wood beads, 1 round wood bead, 3 gemstone beads, 1 round wood bead, 5 gemstone wood beads, 1 round wood bead, 3 gemstone beads, 1 round wood bead, 1 pewter bead, 1 tapered oval wood bead, 1 pewter bead, 1 round wood bead, 3 gemstone beads, 1 roun

4. Now repeat the bead pattern you just did so that the second half of the necklace is a mirror image of the first (basically working in reverse starting with the tassel as the center point). Do not add a crimp bead to this side of the necklace.

5. Once you have strung on all your beads, please watch the video: How to Make a Strung Necklace without a Clasp. This video will show you how to finish off your necklace and crimp the crimp bead. Add a crimp bead cover over your crimped crimp bead.
