



To make these earrings you will be using just two types of beads: a two-hole bead and a seed bead. They are not difficult to make and work up quickly.

1. To start, please cut and thread 36 inches of thread onto your needle.

- FJR-8011 - Silver-Filled Open Jump Rings 4mm 22 Gauge (20 Pieces)
Project uses 2 piece(s). You will need 1 package(s).
- FEA-309 - Earring Findings, Balloon Ear Wire 18x26mm, Sterling Silver (1 Pair)
Project uses 1 pair. You will need 1 package(s).
- BCP-007 - Czech Glass Matubo, Triangular 2-Hole Nib-Bit Beads 5.5x6mm, Double Sided Apollo - Gold (2.5" Tube)
Project uses 12 piece(s). You will need 1 package(s).
- JSK-0096 - Toho Seed Beads, Round 11/0 #2100 'Silver Lined Milky White' (8 Grams)
Project uses 1 tube. You will need 1 package(s).
- XCR-8948 - Wildfire Thermal Bonded Beading Thread, 20 Yard Spool, Frost / White (.006 Inch Thick)
Project uses 72 inches. You will need 1 package(s).
