

If you wanted to, you could make this earring shorter by choosing a different earring hook.

1. Start by placing the following beads onto a head pin: bicone, bead cap facing up, round bead, bicone bead. Create a simple wire loop after the last bead. Trim off excess wire.

- 2. Open the simple wire loop you just made (the same way you would open a jump ring), and connect it to the loop on your earring hook. Close the loop.
- 3. Make your matching earring following the same steps as above. Enjoy!
