



These earrings are a great project for beginners! The only technique to master is how to make a simple wire loop.

1. To make this earring, take a head pin and place beads in the following order onto it: 1 large olive bead, 1 pair of wings, 1 smaller olive bead, 1 daisy spacer.
2. After the last bead, **create a simple wire loop** and trim your tail.
3. Open the loop at the base of the earring hook, the same way you would **open a jump ring**, and slip it onto the simple wire loop. Close the loop back up.
4. Now create the second earring in the same way you made the first. Happy Holidays!
