


Mariella Ring

A large, sparkly crystal chaton draws the eye to this pretty antiqued brass flower ring, which is super quick and easy to make.



Instructions:

- 1. Watch the video: How to Make a Crystal Flower Ring with a Flower Ring Setting.
- 2. As demonstrated in the video, place a ss39 golden shadow crystal chaton into an antiqued brass flower adjustable ring setting, carefully opening the setting petals to fit the chaton.
- 3. If you feel like your ring needs extra stability, you can place a dab of E6000 glue onto the base of your chaton before inserting it into your ring.
- 4. Use a closed pair of chain nosed pliers to carefully bend the setting petals down onto the face of the chaton to secure it in place.
- 5. Adjust the base petals to the desired look. Adjust the ring to the desired size.

Variations

Choose your favorite color crystal chaton to give your flower ring a different feel.

When substituting in items, pay attention to sizes and styles to make sure all your pieces will fit together.
