

Dear Daisy Ring Set in Dark Neons

These rings are adorable and easy to wear, and work up in a snap. Make one of each in four different colors, or combine more than one color in each ring.

What You'll Need

Czech Glass Dagger Spear Beads 10x3mm - Dark Neon Mix (7 Inch Strand)

Czech Glass Druk 4mm Round 'Hematite' (100)

Gun Metal Color Adjustable Ring With 12mm Glue On Plate (4)

Fireline Braided Beading Thread .006 In. - Smoke Grey - 15 Yards

Instructions

1. Before you begin, watch the video: How to Make a Dagger Bead Daisy Ring. This video will demonstrate the steps for making this project.
2. Select ten 10x3mm dagger beads in the color of your choice from the bead mix and string them onto a 2' length of smoke grey Fireline beading thread. Tie a knot a few inches from the tail end of the thread.
3. Bring your needle through the next dagger bead, then string a 4mm hematite druk bead.
4. Enter the dagger beads directly across from where you exited them and bring your needle through the next 5 dagger beads moving in the opposite direction as before.
5. Go back through the druk bead, then go through the other 5 dagger beads back in the original direction. Tie off and weave in your thread.
6. Place a thin layer of E6000 glue onto the glue pad of a gun metal color adjustable ring.

7. Center the beaded daisy onto the glue pad and press into place. Make sure that it's centered and that the petals are arranged evenly.
8. Repeat this process to complete your three additional rings.
9. Allow the glue to dry thoroughly before wearing.
