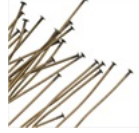

Antiqued Brass Head Pins - 21 Gauge 3 Inches (25)

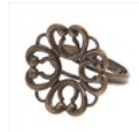

Instructions:

1. To create this ring, place onto a 3" brass head pin 1 Czech Glass drake bead, 1 small white C-Koop enamel flower, 1 medium mustard yellow C-Koop flower, and 1 large teal C-Koop enamel flower. Place the end of the head pin through the center of your ring finding.
2. Next, please watch the video: How to Make a C-Koop Enameled Flower Spinner Ring. This video will show you how to wrap from the head pin around the ring finding to secure the flowers in place and allow the ring to spin.

When substituting in items, pay attention to sizes and styles to make sure all your pieces will fit together.
